Friday - 4th of August - The Master's Apprentice
Competitors in the Moneley Oyster Pearl Races will meet with Junior Sailors. A race advantage is given for boats with Junior Crew.

Saturday - 5th of August - Moneley Oyster Pearl Races
Both the Moneley Oyster Pearl Cruiser Race and the Dinghy Moneley Oyster Pearl will be raced for on this day.

Saturday - 5th of August - Protest Hearings
Protest hearings from the Moneley Oyster Pearl Races will be heard in front of a judging panel and live audience on this evening.

Sunday - 6th of August - Best Dressed Boat Competition
A competition for boats and crew. Boats will do a lap of Carlingford Harbour where the public will cheer for their favourite.

Sunday - 6th of August - The Prize Giving
